The core objective of this workshop was to prepare teaching staff for the online teaching-learning method so that they can challenge the situation of pandemic and also the students should not be suffered.

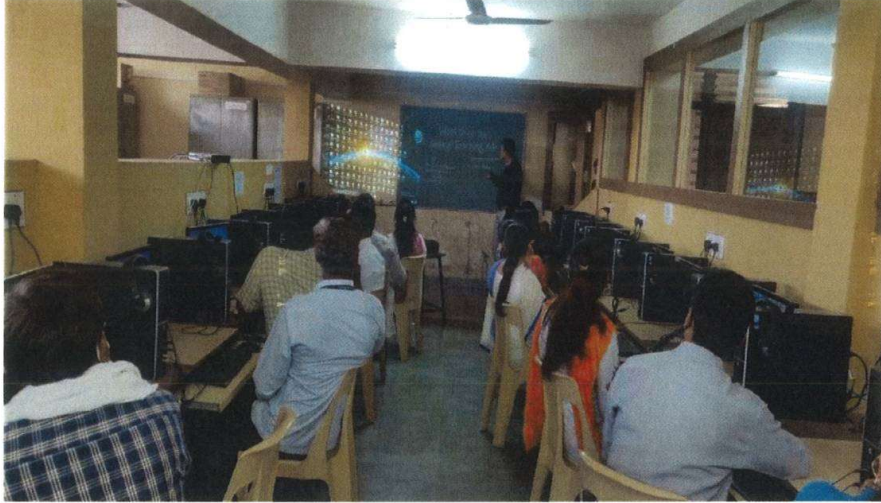
DETAILS
