## **9. Guest Lecture- “Creating Safe Spaces: Tackling Sexual Harassment” on 28/03/2023**

### **Description:-**

On the 28th of March 2023, a guest lecture “Creating Safe Spaces-Tackling Sexual Harassment” was organized by the Women Development Cell of the Institution. The lecture was delivered by Dr. Suprabha Yadgirwar (Secretary, Abhishekh Memorial Foundation, Yavtamal)) a prominent speaker on the subject.

The lecture began with an introduction to the subject of sexual harassment and the various forms it can take. During the session, Dr. Suprabha Yadgirwar emphasized the fact that sexual harassment is a pervasive problem that affects people of all genders and ages, and can occur in various settings such as at home, workplace, and educational institutions.

She explained the role of the police and the judiciary in handling sexual harassment cases and the steps that victims should take if they experience sexual harassment, including the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition, and Redressal) Act, 2013.
