Mahavidyalaya, Wani, Dist. Yavatmal. In his session, he delivered a wonderful lecture on "Mind set for successful Implementation of IKS"

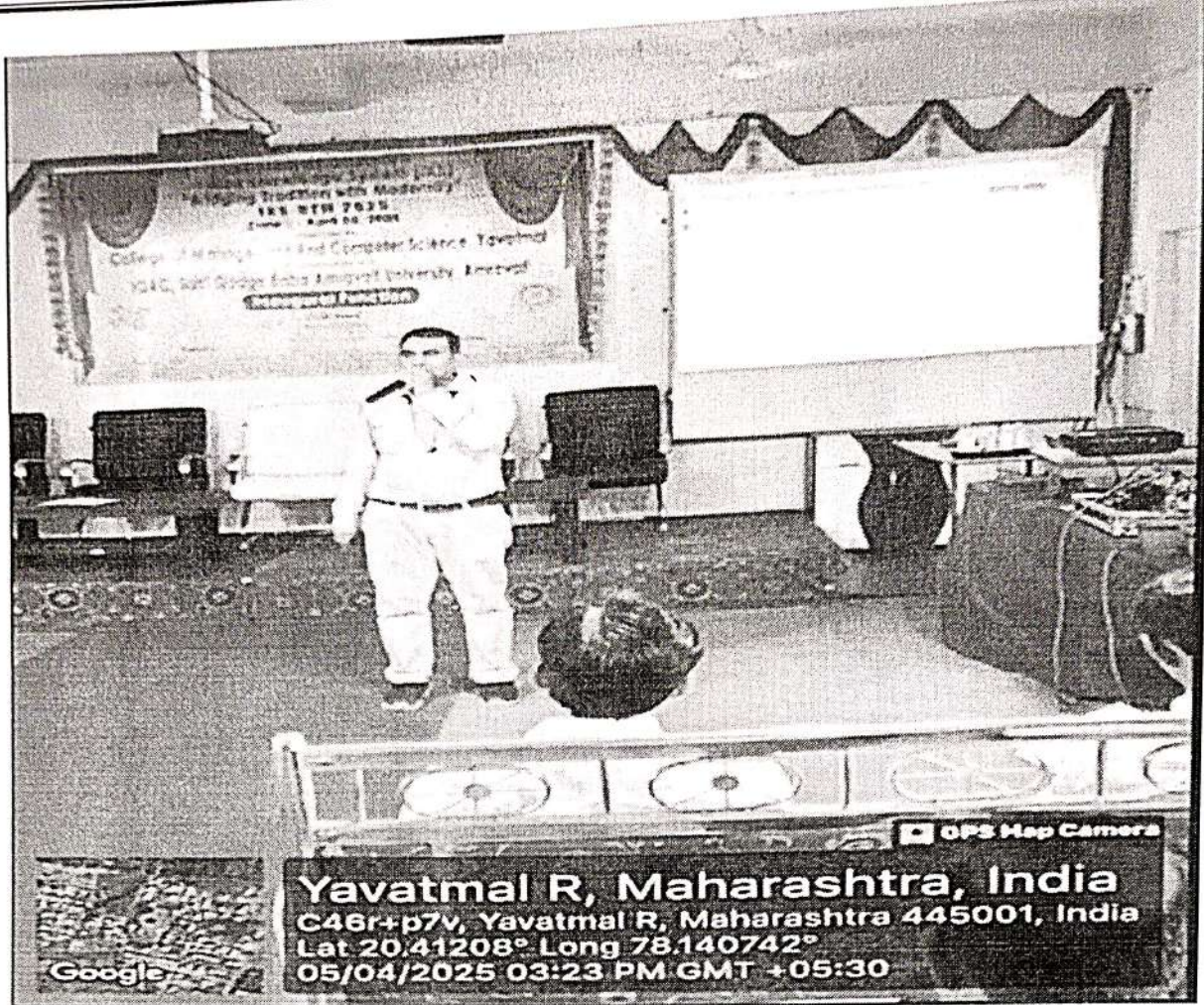

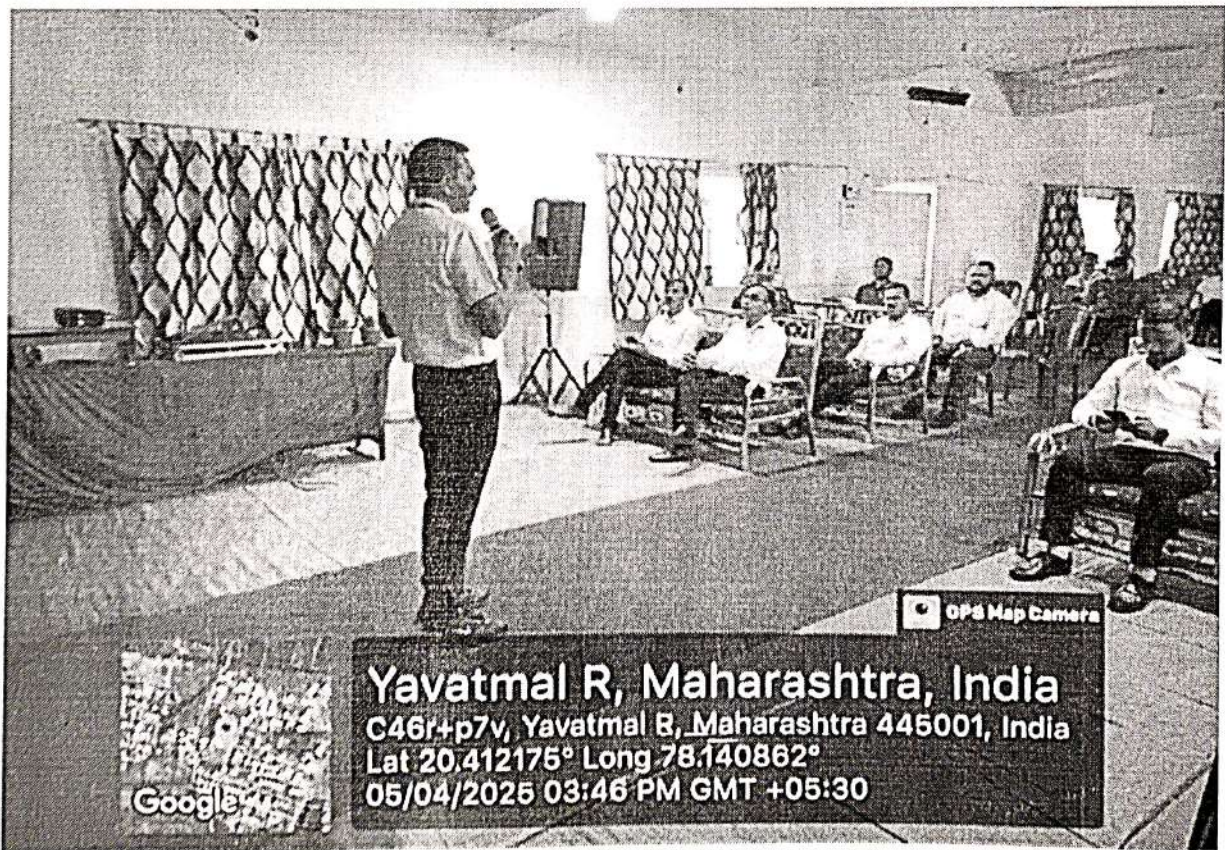
