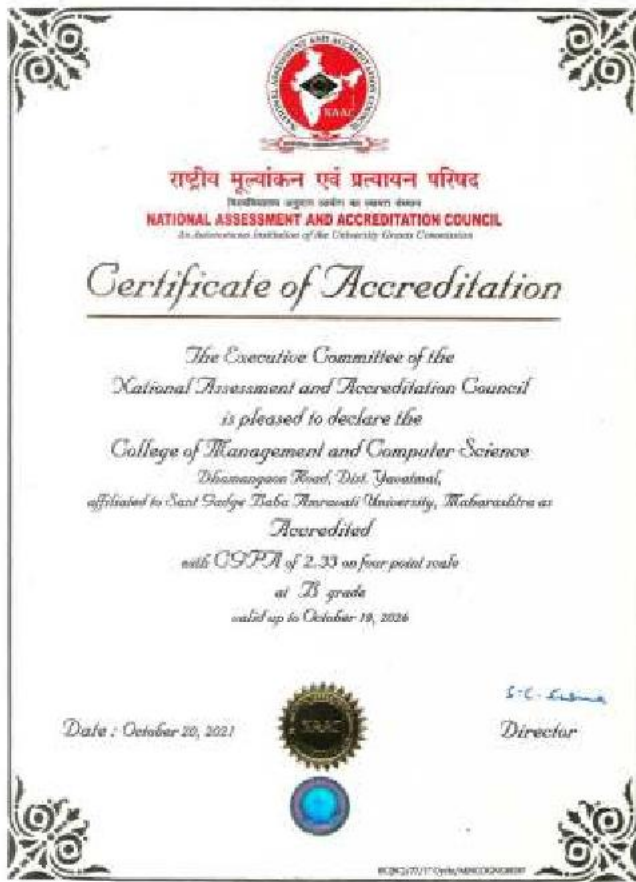

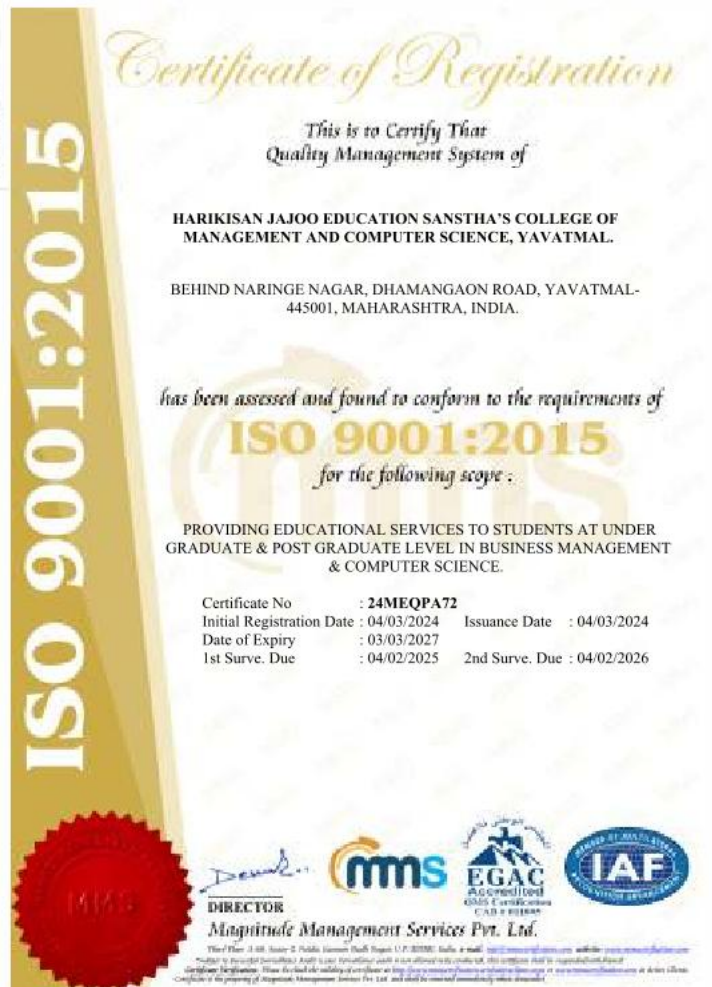

**3. Admissions**

Admissions are done on the basis of rank in Common Entrance Test conducted by MAHA CET. Final allotments will be based on the marks secured in the entrance test. CAP rounds are conducted by Directorate of Technical Education (DTE), Mumbai as per the eligibility criteria constituted By Govt. of India, Govt. of Maharashtra, A.I.C.T.E., D.T.E. and S.G.B. Amravati University whichever applicable.

**4. Fees Of The Course :**

This fees has been decided by Fess Regulatory Authority, Mumbai. It regulatory body of Govt. Of Maharashtra for fixation of Fees of all Professional Courses.

Student has to submit the Demand Draft (D.D.) issued by any nationalized bank for amount of fees prescribed by Shikshan Shulka Samiti, drawn in favor of "College Of Management And Computer Science, Department Of Management, Yavatmal."

#### **5. Admission Cancellation Process Of The Courses :**

The Process of cancellation of admission is being conducted according to the rules of Govt. of India, Govt. of Maharashtra, A.I.E.T.E., D.T.E. and S.G.B. Amravati University whichever applicable.

#### **6. Teaching methodology of M.B.A. program At CMCS :**

##### **A. Case Study :**

During lectures, various Cases are put forth for discussion by our lecturers, which help students to apply their knowledge to different business situations. The Library contains numerous books on case studies in various subjects which can prove a great help to students.

##### **B. Management Games :**

Learning through games is one of the important techniques to imbibe students with necessary skills. Different management games are conducted as a part of curriculum through which practical knowledge is imparted.

##### **C. Group Study :**

Students are motivated to participate in Group Discussions on various topics. Also, they are encouraged to undertake doubt solving sessions with the help faculty.

##### **D. Assignment / Presentation :**

All the Students are required to submit assignments on each subject when directed by the faculty members. The students are also required to give Presentation on selected topics, in the class. This helps in enhancing one's Communication Skills and understanding the effective use of Audio / Visual Aids. These activities enable the faculty members to judge the Student's Progress.

##### **E. Sessional Examination :**

## General Rules And Regulations

Following rules of the institution are framed by the Committee, specially constituted for the purpose and these rules have the approval of the Director / Principal. All students are required to follow these rules.

1. Class attendance is compulsory to all the students seeking admission to M.B.A. course.
2. All academic activities like Seminars, Guest Lectures, Group Discussions, Project work and Home Assignments are necessary components of the curriculum. The attendance and participation of each student will be reviewed by the teaching faculty from time to time for assessing his / her performances.
3. Students must take care of the institutions property, especially the classroom furniture and fitting and also maintain it property. If any damage is notified, will be recovered from the whole class.
4. Identity Card :

Every student will be provided an identity card from the college after submitting one self-thumb size photograph. it is essential for every college student to carry their identity card with them while they are in the college premises. Loss of the card must be reported immediately to the office clerk He / She will get the new I-card after paying the fine of Rs. 250/- and submission of one thumb size photograph.

5. Students are prohibited from forming associations / organization & from holding function in the college without the prior permission of the principal. Students are prohibited from organizing welcome, farewell and other such function outside college premises. The Principal's discipline and General rules and other important instruction mentioned in this Prospectus shall be final & binding to all.
6. Smoking or intake of any unhygienic product in the premises is prohibited, Any student doing such things will be liable for penal action.
7. Ragging is strictly prohibited by the college as well as by a new law enforced by the Govt. of Maharashtra and Central Govt. Any Student found guilty regarding in aforesaid issue he / she will be liable for strict penal action and legal processing thereof.

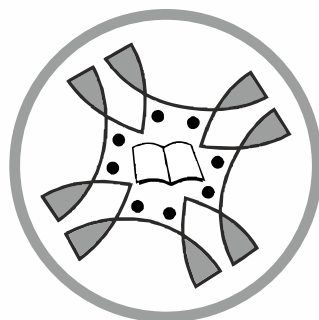
